PARIS-ROME - Gavioli/arr. Johan van Veen

In de wereld van het draaiorgel zijn er twee legendarische namen: Carl Frei en Anselmo Gavioli, beide zowel bouw- als componist. Na een verzuchting van rechter Mr. Romke de Waard, voorzitter van de Vereniging van draaiorgelvrienden, dat het hoog tijd werd dat die prachtige draaiorgelmusiek van beide componisten voor blaskorkest werd gearrangeerd, bewerkte de in Canada wonende Nederlander Johan van Veen deze flitsende galop voor harmonieorkest.

In der Geschichte der Drehorgel gibt es zwei legendarische Namen: Carl Frei und Anselmo Gavioli, die beide Orgelbauer und Komponist waren. Richter Romke de Waard, Vorsitzender des "Vereins der Freunde der Drehorgel" wünschte daß die Perlen der Drehorgelmusik für Blaskorchester arrangiert würden. Der in Kanada wohnende niederländische Komponist Johan van Veen hat diesen spritzenden Galopp für Blaskorchester arrangiert.

Il y a deux noms légendaires dans l'histoire de l'orgue de barbarie: Carl Frei et Anselmo Gavioli, tous les deux facteurs d'orgue et compositeurs. C'était un vœu pieux du juge Romke de Waard, Président de "l'Association des Amis de l'Orgue de Barbarie", que les joyaux de la musique pour orgue mécanique soient arrangés pour orchestre à vent. Johan van Veen, citoyen néerlandais résident au Canada, a transcrit ce pétillant galop pour orchestre d'harmonie.

PARIS-ROME - Gavioli/arr. Johan van Veen

There are two legendary names in the barrel organ history: Carl Frei and Anselmo Gavioli. Both were instrument manufacturer and composer as well. It was a pious wish of judge Romke de Waard, President of the Barrel Organ Friends Society, that some of the best barrel organ tunes could be arranged for wind band. The Dutch composer Johan van Veen, living in Canada, made a nice transcription for wind band of this sparkling galop.
