## ORNAMENTS :

What is the difference between a perfect 5th and a diminished one?
Where in a major scale does one find a perfect 5th ? A diminished 5th ?


The basic baroque trill is one which you will meet in a great deal of music. It starts with an appoggiatura (a grace note on the beat) and the trill stops on the dot.

The appoggiatura $=\frac{1}{4}$ of the trill beat, or the same length as the
penultimate note. The dot (when one stops trilling) also $=\frac{1}{4} \delta$ ) in this instance.

Therefore the basic trill can be divided into 4 sections.

1) appoggiatura.
2) trill
3) dot
4) tailpiece.
