## PROGRAM NOTE

A martial introduction sets the mood for the opening theme of this composition. Its contemporary flavor is enhanced by a rich melody and contrasting second theme. The composition closes with the original theme being restated. This work is truly a blending of varied musical elements.

## CONDUCTOR'S NOTE

"Kings Go Forth" is in A-B-A form with a development of the introduction separating the A and B themes. This section, $\mathrm{C}-\mathrm{D}$, should be played in a crisp, brilliant style, Careful attention should be given to the bass line at A. It should be staccato, but not too "chopped". On the other hand, be sure to retain the legato feeling in the woodwind accompaniment at $D$.
