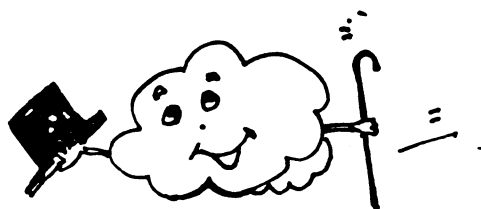


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Stems Up, Stems Down

When you are writing music, you must know where to put the stems on your notes.

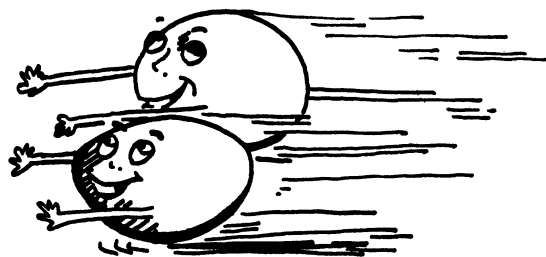
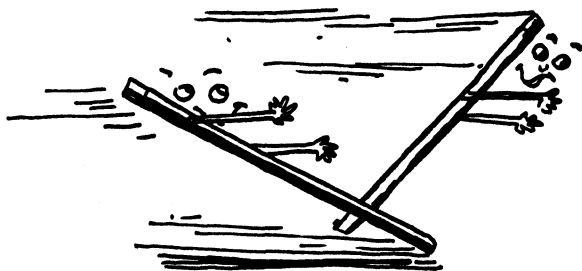
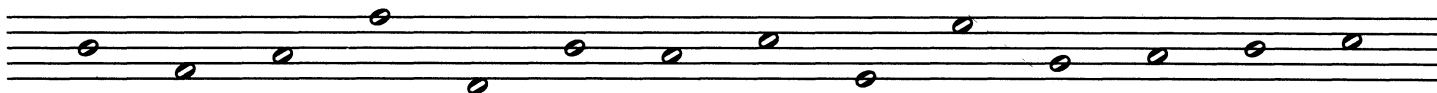
stem rules:


1. notes on or above the middle line = stems *down*
2. notes below the middle line = stems *up*



-  Up stems are *always* on the right side of the note head.
-  Down stems are *always* on the left side of the note head.

Flags on eighth notes always go to the right.  

 Add stems. Remember the rules!



 Finish these notes.

1. add *up stems* or *down stems*
2. darken note head if quarter or eighth
3. add flags on eighth notes . Side-by-side eighth notes may be joined by a beam  instead of separate flags.

$1/2$ = half note



$1/4$ = quarter note



$1/8$ = eighth note
