

Come, Christians, Join to Sing! is an anthem for Christ the King Sunday, Ascension, and general occasions. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include 2 Samuel 5:1-5, Psalm 95, John 12:9-19, and Colossians 1:11-20. One basic homiletical theme is issuing the call to the community of the faithful: come and worship Jesus Christ, your King!

In rehearsal, strive for four-measure phrases sung with an articulate legato. Sensitive text declamation and proper tempo should produce a feeling of two beats per measure. However, do not allow the anthem to become too “march-like” in character. Shape each phrase with careful dynamic gradations, guided by the strong pull of the underlying eighth notes in the accompaniment. Verses 1 and 3 (mm. 5-24 and 45-62) should be slightly more declamatory than the very lyric second verse.
