**Standing on the Promises** is a vibrant new arrangement by Mark Hayes of a traditional gospel hymn. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include Psalm 34, Isaiah 43: 1-11, 2 Corinthians 1: 18-24 and 2 Peter 1: 1-11. One basic homiletical theme is the assurance of God's steadfast love and guidance for all True Believers as they journey through the hardships of life.

In rehearsal, strive for a bright, energetic choral sound free of unnecessary vibrato. Rehearse the entire anthem on staccato "oo" until all of the rhythms are uniformly articulated. A solo voice may be assigned to perform mm. 5-12 and 24-31.

**R. (Russell) Kelso Carter** was born in Baltimore, Maryland, on November 18, 1849, and died in Catonsville, Maryland, on August 23, 1928. An ordained Methodist minister, professor of science, engineering and mathematics, and author, Carter also became in his later years a practicing physician. He composed and published **Standing on the Promises** in 1886.

**Mark Hayes** is an award-winning concert pianist, composer and arranger of sacred choral, piano, and orchestral music. With over 400 published works to his credit, Mark has also recorded numerous solo piano albums and has received the Gospel Music Association's prestigious Dove Award, which is equivalent to a Grammy in gospel music. A graduate of Baylor University, he has served as an adjunct professor of composition at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Kansas City, Missouri.
