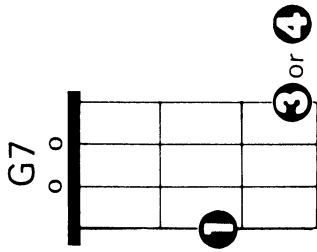
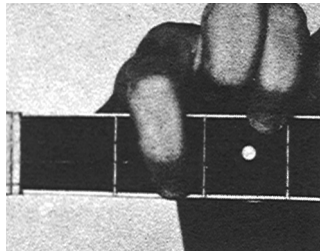
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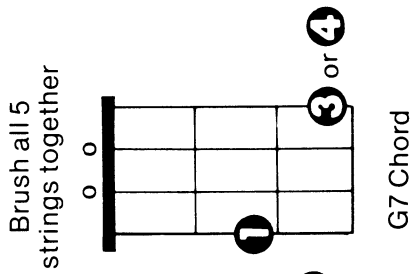


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HOW TO PLAY THE G⁷ CHORD



Place **1** and **3** in position, then pluck 1 string at a time.



G7 Chord

PLUCK VARIATIONS

It is not necessary for the index finger always to pluck the 1st string. You can pluck the 2nd, 3rd or 4th strings also and you can mix them within a particular song. In the following exercises, mix your plucking as follows: A) All with the 1st string; B) All with the 2nd string; C) Alternate the 1st and 2nd strings with each measure; D) All on the 3rd string; E) All on the 4th string; F) Alternate the 3rd and 4th strings with each measure; G) Any combination at all.

Repeat each line several times. Gradually increase your tempo (speed). As your tempo increases, it is natural to assume you will miss the 5th and possibly the 4th strings as you brush.
