The God of Israel said:

Music of the Morning is a general anthem that may be especially appropriate for Eastertide and Ascension. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include 2 Samuel 23: 1-4, Psalms 72: 1-7 & 139: 7-12, saiah 54: 11-15, Hosea 6: 1-3, John 20: 1-18 and Revelation 21: 22-27. One basic homiletical theme is Jesus, Lamb of God and Light of the World.

In rehearsal, strive for a light, articulate legato, rehearsing the entire piece on staccato "doo" until rhythms are cleanly articulated. In worship, this anthem may be particularly effective when followed by the choir and congregation singing the traditional hymn, When Morning Gilds the Skies.
