**Blessed Is He** is an anthem for Palm Sunday that incorporates the traditional hymn, *Hosanna Loud Hosanna*. Featuring parts for optional unison children's choir and congregation, it may be especially appropriate as a processional anthem or opening hymn concertato. The finale (mm. 61-end) may be sung as a worship response. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include Psalm 118: 26, Zechariah 9: 9, Matthew 21: 1-11, Mark 11: 1-11, Luke 19: 28-40 and John 12: 12-16. One basic homiletical theme is shouting "hosanna" to the King of Glory who will die and rise again from the dead for our salvation.

**Jay Althouse** has written choral music for all levels of school and church choirs. He has over 450 choral compositions and arrangements in print. Jay received a B.S. in Music Education and an M.Ed. in Music from Indiana University of Pennsylvania.
