I Want to Walk as a Child of the Light is a new hymn by Kathleen Thomerson, arranged by Benjamin Harlan for SATB and SAB voices with optional children's choir and congregation. Appropriate for performance throughout the year, it is especially suited for services of baptism, child or family dedication, confirmation and stewardship. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include Psalm 119: 97-105, Matthew 5: 14, John 8: 1-12, Ephesians 5: 8-10 and Colossians 1: 9-14. One basic homiletical theme is journeying through life in righteousness and truth, guided by the Light of God.

A unison children's choir or solo voice may sing alone in mm. 9-28 and 51-58, and with the choir as indicated. Any of the three verses of this remarkable hymn may be sung in unison by itself as a choral or congregational worship response.

Benjamin Harlan is Dean of the School of Church Music at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas. With degrees from Baylor University and Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Dr. Harlan is a widely celebrated church choral composer, arranger and clinician.

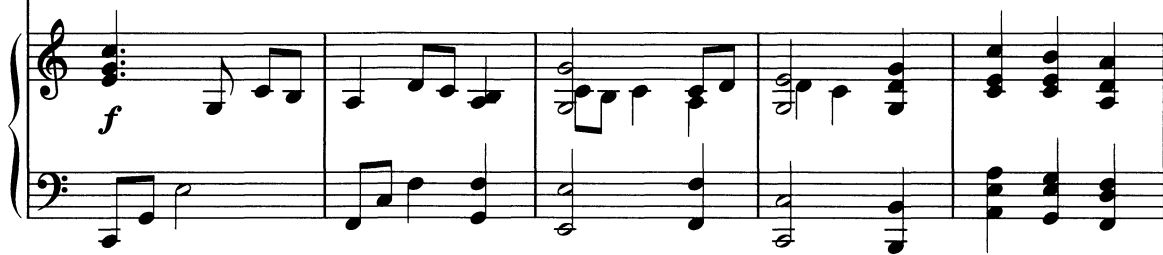
