

### ***Editor's Note***

Franz Joseph Haydn (1732-1809) was one of the most notable composers of the Classic era. Born in Austria, Haydn was an important influence in establishing the Classical style in the eighteenth century. He composed numerous instrumental and vocal works in the various forms of his day.

This publication provides the *Kyrie* and *Gloria* movements of Haydn's "Kleine Orgelmesse" ("Little Organ Mass"), which is also known as "Missa brevis Sancti Joannis de Deo." The mass was written in the 1770s for performance in the Eisenstadt chapel of the Brothers of Mercy to honor the founder of the order, St. John of God.

Composed for use in the main worship service of the Catholic Church, a missa brevis (brief mass) in Haydn's time was quite concise and few instruments were employed. Haydn scored this mass for S.A.T.B. voices with a soprano soloist in the *Benedictus* and an accompaniment of only two violins, continuo and organ. Additionally, he employed polytextual settings of the Latin words in the *Gloria* and *Credo* sections for brevity.

The *Kyrie* and *Gloria* movements are presented here in their original key with a keyboard accompaniment which is a reduction of Haydn's instrumental parts. The metronomic and dynamic indications as well as the customary plainchant at the beginning of the *Gloria* have been added to this edition.

The *Kyrie* should be sung very smoothly and expressively, and the *Gloria*, beginning at the bass entrance, should be performed quite rhythmically and energetically. The introductory chant should be performed freely while energizing the naturally emphasized syllables within the two-note and three-note groupings. Singers should emphasize the normally stressed syllables throughout the two movements. Accent marks are indicated over those syllables in the Latin Pronunciation Guide on page 16.
