The piece is set in D major and contains two sections. The first section is a slow fanfare, great for playing with long bows and producing full, rich tones. The second section features eighth and quarter note rhythms, to highlight playing with short, rapid bow strokes. The opening melody returns near the end for a grand finale. All sections in the orchestra are featured, and the parts are playable entirely in first position.
