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A compact disc is included with this book. This disc can make learning easier and more enjoyable. The symbol at the top appears next to every example that is on the CD. Use the CD to help ensure that you're capturing the feel of the examples, interpreting the rhythms correctly, and so on. The track number next to the symbol corresponds directly to the example(s) you want to hear. Track 1 will help you tune your pedal steel guitar to the CD.
