Were You There? is a haunting adaptation of the traditional spiritual in which the original $\frac{4}{4}$ meter has been changed to $\frac{2}{4}$, and the keyboard has a lyric, meditative quality. Especially well-suited to Maundy Thursday or Good Friday, it is also ideal for Passion (Palm) Sunday and other times during the church year. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include Psalm 22 and 31, Isaiah 52: 13 – 53: 12, Mark 15: 1-39, and John 18: 1 – 19: 42.

Larry Shackley directs the music program at Columbia (SC) International University and holds a D.M.A. in composition from the University of South Carolina. Previously, he was staff composer for Moody Broadcasting in Chicago, and keyboardist/arranger at Willow Creek Community Church (South Barrington, IL). His choral and keyboard arrangements, broadcast themes and film scores have been heard around the world.

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
