FOREWORD

The 22 well-known hymns presented in this book will provide enjoyable material that will reinforce each new principle and concept introduced in the Level 3 Lesson Book of ALFRED'S BASIC PIANO LIBRARY.

Additional experience will be gained in the use of extended positions, reviewing the principal chords of the keys previously studied, crossing 1 under 2 and under 3, the keys of F major, A minor and D minor, overlapping pedal, and compound time signatures. In addition to these, the student will benefit from the phrasing, dynamics and rhythmic variety present in these pieces.

For those who are particularly motivated by sacred music, this book should provide many hours of musical enjoyment that will result in improvement in the performance of music of all types.
