Bring Your Drums, Jeannette, Isabella, which is based on the traditional French carol "Bring a Torch, Jeannette, Isabella" features the percussion section. It is appropriate for winter holiday concerts for students in their second year of band.

The tom-tom part may be played by as many percussionists as you desire. The part may also be performed on any drum, including congas, bongos, or timbales. The dynamic levels may need to be adjusted depending on how many percussionists are utilized.

Dynamic levels may also need to be balanced in the winds, especially in the section beginning at measure 38. Also, please note that all quarter notes should be played full-value unless marked otherwise.

I hope you and your ensemble find *Bring Your Drums, Jeannette, Isabella* to be a fun and worthwalle musical experience!
