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## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The opening figure is repeated several times throughout the arrangement. Direct the ensemble to play this figure crisp, light, and with accurate articulation. The *staccato* markings are short, but not too short or clipped. Notes with *tenuto* markings should get their full values. As a “pop ballad,” the entire performance should be tasty, sensitive, and well controlled dynamically—understated is best. If you have a percussionist in addition to your drummer, bell tree and wind chimes can be added. This adds a nice timbre to the ensemble, but make sure any percussion embellishment is subtle and not overpowering.

The first chorus, beginning at measure 10, shifts the melody among all the sections. The drums should be playing eighthths on a closed hi-hat with rim knocks on beat 3 for a contemporary pop/rock feel. The flute, clarinet, and vibes parts are optional, but they will add nice color if used.

At measure 34, the opening figure returns, and the drummer should play the part on different parts of the cymbals as indicated (light domes, not crashes). Alto saxophone has the solo melody at measure 43, and the piano part should be played as written in this section.

The high point in the chart is at measure 62. Be sure the chord is full and well balanced, without being over-played. The rhythmic variation in measures 66–67 might need to be conducted, as will the slight *rallentando* that ends the chart.

The rhythm section parts are written out. Guitar comping should be light and understated. For the best sound, ask the guitarist to use medium-thick picks, held loosely between the thumb and index finger. This will give the sound an acoustic quality. The guitarist’s quarter-note rhythm should perfectly mesh with the bass so that they merge into one big sound.
