

PERFORMANCE NOTES

The daily comic strip *Little Orphan Annie* debuted in 1924 and attracted readers with its political commentary of the time. Topics included the Great Depression and the New Deal, brought to life through the now classic characters of Annie, her dog Sandy, and her wealthy benefactor Oliver “Daddy” Warbucks.

The original Broadway production of *Annie* opened in 1977, won the Tony Award for Best Musical, and ran for nearly six years. Since that time it has been adapted for film in 1982, for television in 1999, and again for film in 2014. This arrangement is based on the 2014 film that takes place in present day New York City. The girls begin the song by creating various rhythm patterns with brooms and cleaning supplies.

The rhythmic, hip-hop feel of this arrangement could be complemented through the use of the suggested body percussion, rhythm instruments, or movement as desired. In addition, soloists could be used in measures 24-27 and 41-47.
