Now My Spirit Sings – The warmly compelling melody of this anthem makes it an ideal addition to your congregation's Advent and Christmas season. It begins with an optional solo for medium voice, set to the words of Mary from Luke 1:46, which are eventually taken up by the entire choir as all the world joins to glorify the Lord who has "done great things." Stirring four-part writing continues as the words from Isaiah 9:6 are proclaimed, building in intensity, as Mary's words return in a profoundly worshipful conclusion. This highly expressive choral offering features a flowing piano accompaniment, while a score for optional chamber orchestra is also available.

Lee Dengler is a composer and arranger with over 300 published choral anthems, books for vocal and piano solo, and Christmas and Holy Week cantatas to his credit. He studied choral composition and arranging with Alice Parker and received his Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees from West Chester University in West Chester, PA. He is a freelance music editor and engraver.

Susan Naus Dengler is a lyricis and writer, as well as a children's choir conductor, soprano soloist, and voice teacher. She received degrees in Music Education from West Chester University and Church Music and Vocal Performance from Valparaiso University.
