PROGRAM NOTES

"I'm Seventeen Come Sunday" is a popular British folk song probably written in the mid-nineteenth century. This arrangement is based on the Percy Grainger choral and brass band arrangement written in 1905–1912. English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams also used this folk song as the basis of the first movement of his *English Folk Song Suite*.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Varying articulations play an important role in this arrangement. Careful observation of all articulations is critical to a musical performance. Unless otherwise marked, all unmarked quarter notes should be played full-value.

In measures 96–99, the tuba part is written in octaves. Your tubists should choose the notes that they are most comfortable with.

I hope you and your ensemble find "I'm Seventeen Come Sunday" to be an exciting piece, and a meaningful introduction to the work of Percy Grainger.
