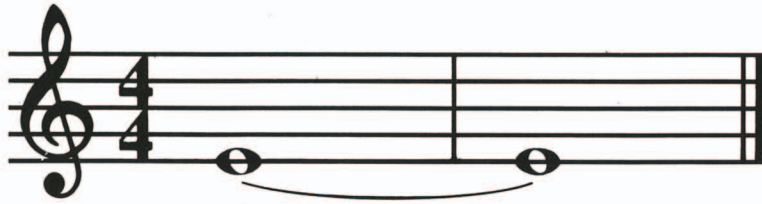


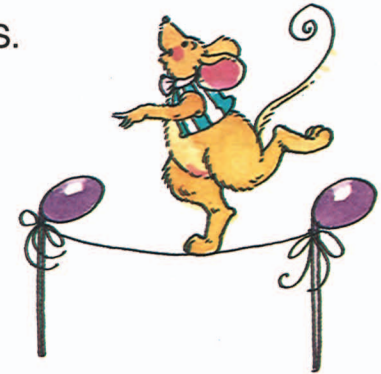
Tied Notes

When notes on the **SAME LINE** or **SAME SPACE** are joined by a curved line, we call them **TIED NOTES**.

The key is held down for the **COMBINED VALUES OF BOTH NOTES**.



COUNT: "1 - 2 - 3 - 4, 1 - 2 - 3 - 4"

If the notes are the **SAME**— it's a **TIE!**



Hold the notes, without repeating!

If the notes are **DIFFERENT**— it's a **SLUR**.



Connect the notes, LEGATO!
