Two Lenten Anthems is a set that is also appropriate for more general services including stewardship, confirmation, and the commissioning or ordination of church officers and teachers. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include John 14: 6 and Hebrews 12: 2. One basic homilitical theme is that of Jesus as perfector of our faith.

For unaccompanied performances of these anthems, rehearse them as much as possible without the keyboard, using a neutral vowel to promote uniform tone color and proper intonation. In **Show Me the Way, O Lord**, highlight the movement from the dissonant intervals of the seventh and ninth to the consonant octave between the alto and bass (m. 1-2, etc.) and rehearse the three upper voices in m. 1-4 without the basses. Proper text inflection and balance of voice parts will provide the most effective performance of **Son of God, Son of Man**. In both anthems, discreet keyboard doubling of the vocal parts may be used.
