## **PROGRAM NOTES**

Edvard Grieg (1843-1907) is considered the most important Norwegian composer from the nationalist-Romantic period drawing the majority of his inspiration from Norwegian folk music. Brought up in a musical family, Grieg was also an accomplished pianist. That emphasis on the melodic/harmonic flow so important to his characteristic style is supremely evident in this transcription scored by Michael Story.
