NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR


Snare drummers should use wire brushes to capture the chugging train sound of the steam locomotive. Also, a toy train whistle is a <u>must</u> to recreate the sound of the steam engine. These train whistles are available in most music and/or novelty stores. This arrangement does not have any challenging technical problems, and it should be fun to learn and perform. If possible, the sound of the train whistle should be amplified.
