

STAFF




5 lines and 4 spaces.

CLEF SIGN (Treble)




BAR




Divides the staff into measures.

MEASURE




Space between two bars.

DOUBLE BAR



Marks the end of a section.

WHOLE NOTE




Receives 4 beats

WHOLE REST



Receives 4 beats


TIME SIGNATURE



4 Counts or Beats in each measure.

Notes and Musical Terms used for the first time are pointed out with ARROWS. They should be memorized.




Let old air out first.
