

# FLOR PEETERS

Flor Peeters — composer, organist, teacher — was born on July 4, 1903 in Tielen, Belgium. Following his studies at the Lemmens Institute, where he won highest honors in organ playing and composition, he became closely associated with Marcel Dupré and Charles Tournemire.

In 1925 he became professor at the Lemmens Institute and organist at the Metropolitan Cathedral of Mechelen. In 1952 he became organ professor and director of the Royal Flemish Conservatory in Antwerp. He has won international acclaim based upon his recitals in Europe, Canada, South Africa, and in the United States.

In 1952 the Catholic University of America conferred on him the degree of Doctor of Music, *honoris causa*.

His compositions include some of the best-known choruses and organ music performed today. His orchestral works, chamber music, and piano compositions are represented in many important European and American catalogs. His *Little Organ Book*, a highly respected method book for the beginning organ student, is published by Summy-Birchard Music.
