

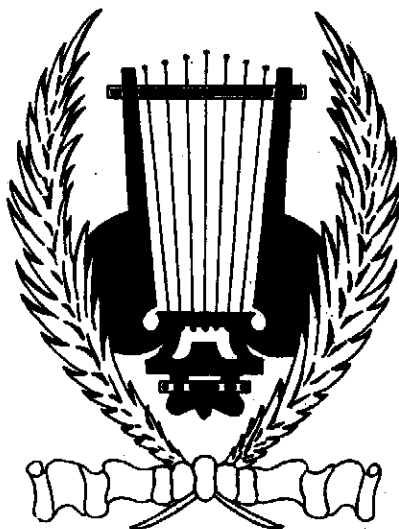

TRIO
